Diversity

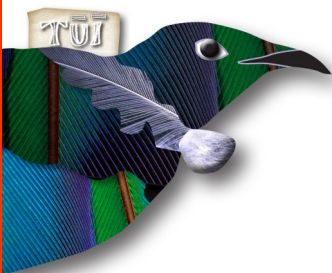
