Yesterday's disco was a lot of fun - it was great to see so much actual dancing! The kids were awesome. Thanks to the staff who got stuck in during lunch time to get set up and for cleaning up afterwards to have the room ready for the whakatau this morning.

We enjoyed meeting some of our new and current families at the New Families Breakfast and Whakatau this morning. Thank you to the PTA for helping with the breakfast set up and clean-up and to our trusty toast makers, Arlo, Aimi and Harry.

The leadership team has been working through the options for staffing and year level organisation for 2024. We have taken the opportunity to consider how the classes are arranged to support teachers to work within the new phases. Our discussions have focused around Te Mātaiaho | the refreshed NZ curriculum which replaces curriculum levels and achievement objectives with five phases of learning: Years 1-3, Years 4-6, Years 7-8, Years 9-10 and Years 11-13. Learning that cannot be left to chance is described in these five phases, each phase setting out 8 progress outcomes and progress steps. Elements of Understand, Know, and Do for each learning area clearly lay out the big ideas, contexts, and practices for each area and enable increasingly rigorous and complex learning.

Phase 1 (years 0-3)

Te tupu pāhautea i te taiao ako e haumako ana i te reo matatini me te pāngarau

Thriving in environments rich in literacy and numeracy

• Phase 2 (years 4-6)

Te whakawhānui i ngā pae o te mātauranga me te mahi tahi Expanding horizons of knowledge and collaborating

Once they leave Ngaio School Phase 3 takes students through years 7 & 8 and phases 4 and 5 take tauira through to the end of secondary school.

We are getting close to deciding on the year groupings and placement of teachers for 2024 and will communicate this once settled.
